# Video Tips

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- Script
  - Start writing early!
  - Ask your clients for input
- Ideas
  - Think about the problem your system addresses
  - Focus on the important/interesting aspects, not minor details such as the login screen

# Video Tips

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- Filming
  - Record many takes!
  - Have more content than you need
- Audio
  - Record many takes!
  - Pause between phrases
