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Project Overview

- Dow processing plants need water for a variety of purposes.
- Water should not be taken from areas that are already stressed.
- Need a web based application to view water table data.
- Application can be used to determine which areas are safe to take water from.
- Will be used to analyze water impact for each site over the course of years

Functional Specifications

- Interactive map that displays Dow plant locations
- Plant locations are indicated by a click-able icon called a pin.
- Clicking on a pin brings up a dialog box from which you can select a variety of options.
- Options include adding another plant for comparison or opening the current plant in another page to view tabular and graphical data.
- Map will be reusable. Will be able to add additional data other than water usage.
- Map used for viewing data. No need for user registration or password protection.




- Using Bing maps

Screen Mockup: Interactive Map




Screen Mockup: Pin Selection

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

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Technical Specifications

- Graphical and tabular reports generated via SQL Server Reporting Services (SSRS).
- SharePoint used to coordinate interaction between map, reports, and raw data using web parts.
- PowerPivot used to convert, sort, and query data between applications.
- Web map created using MS Silverlight and XAML.

Testing

- Bottom Up Integration testing
