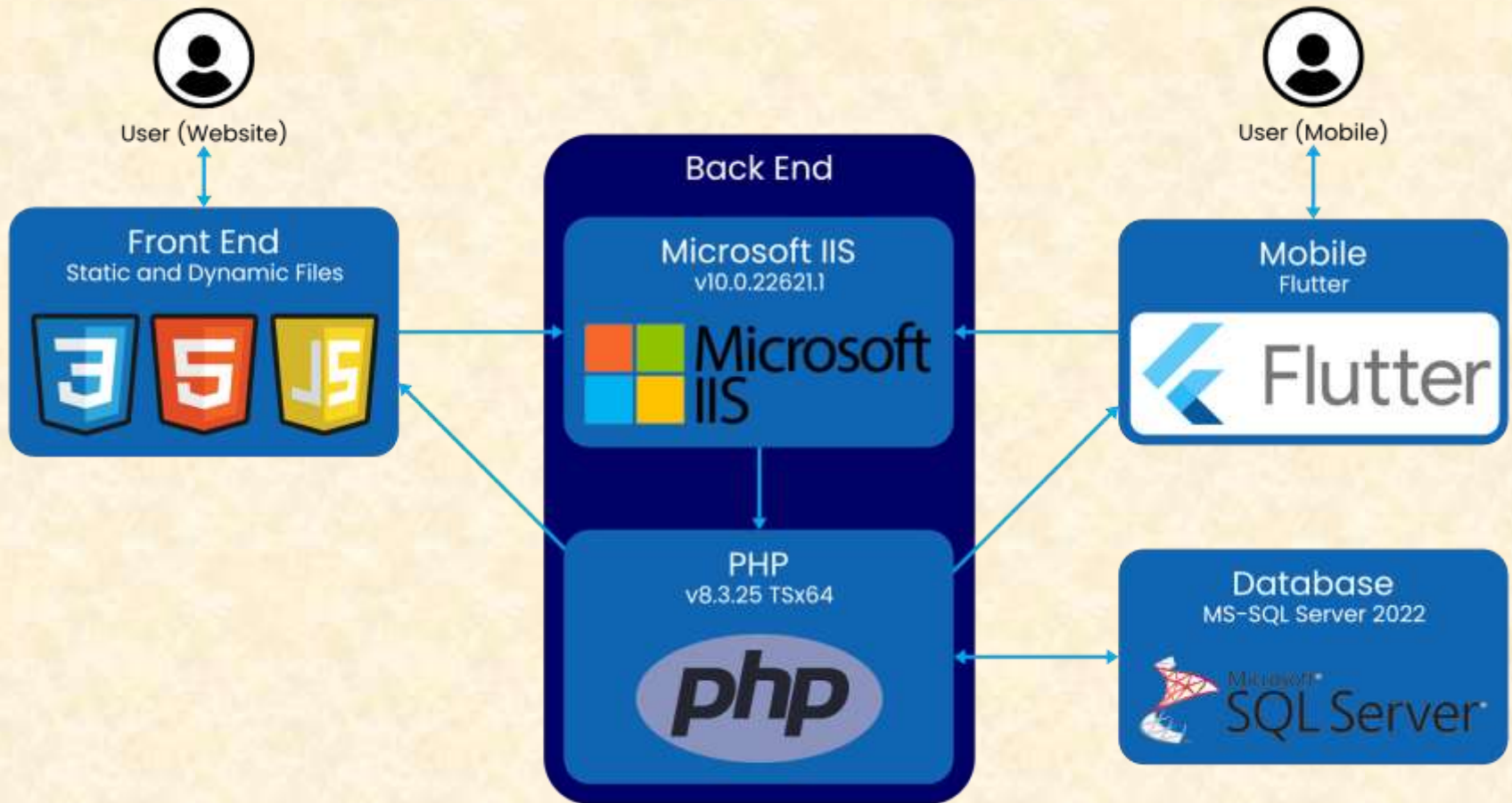

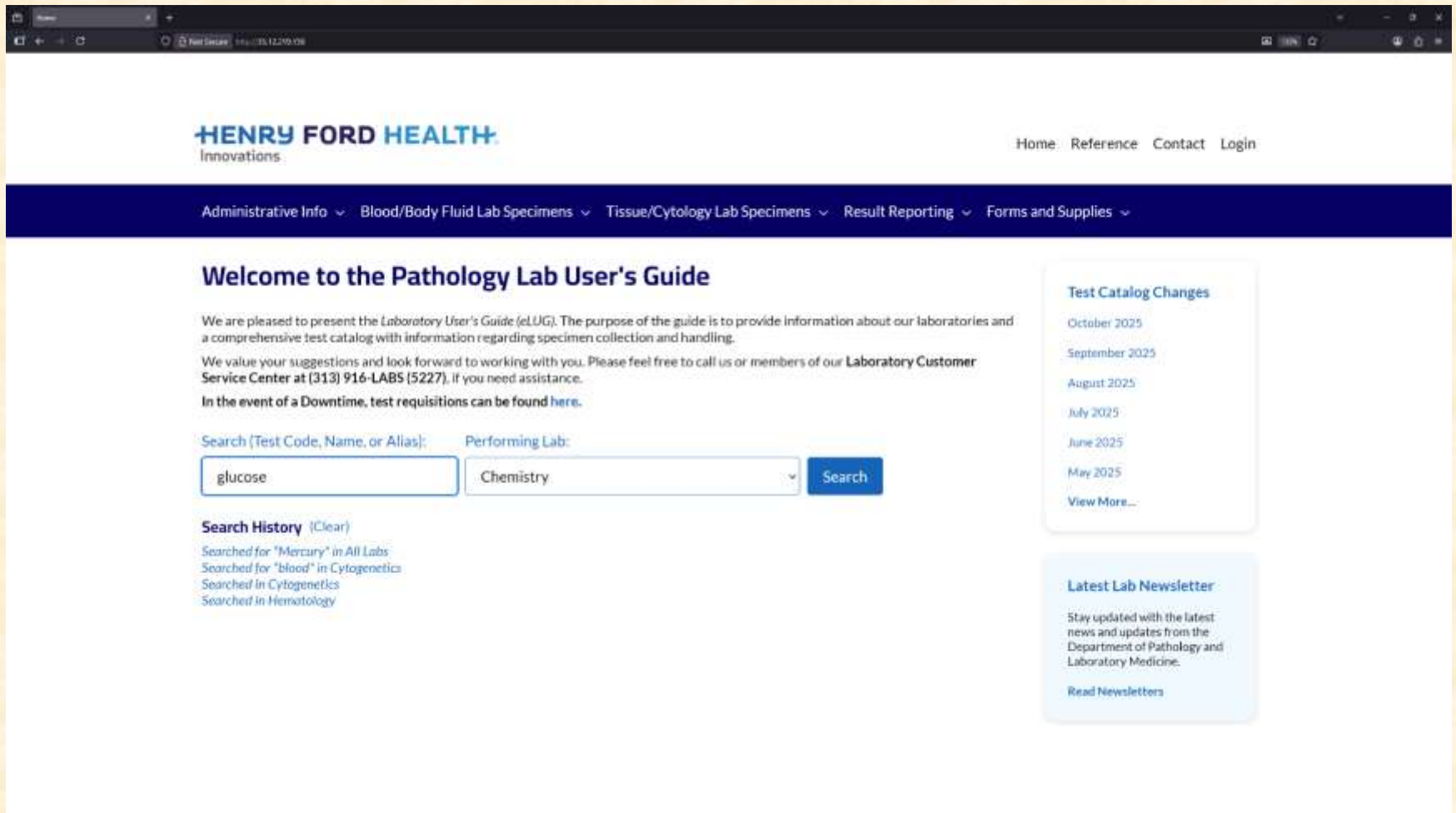

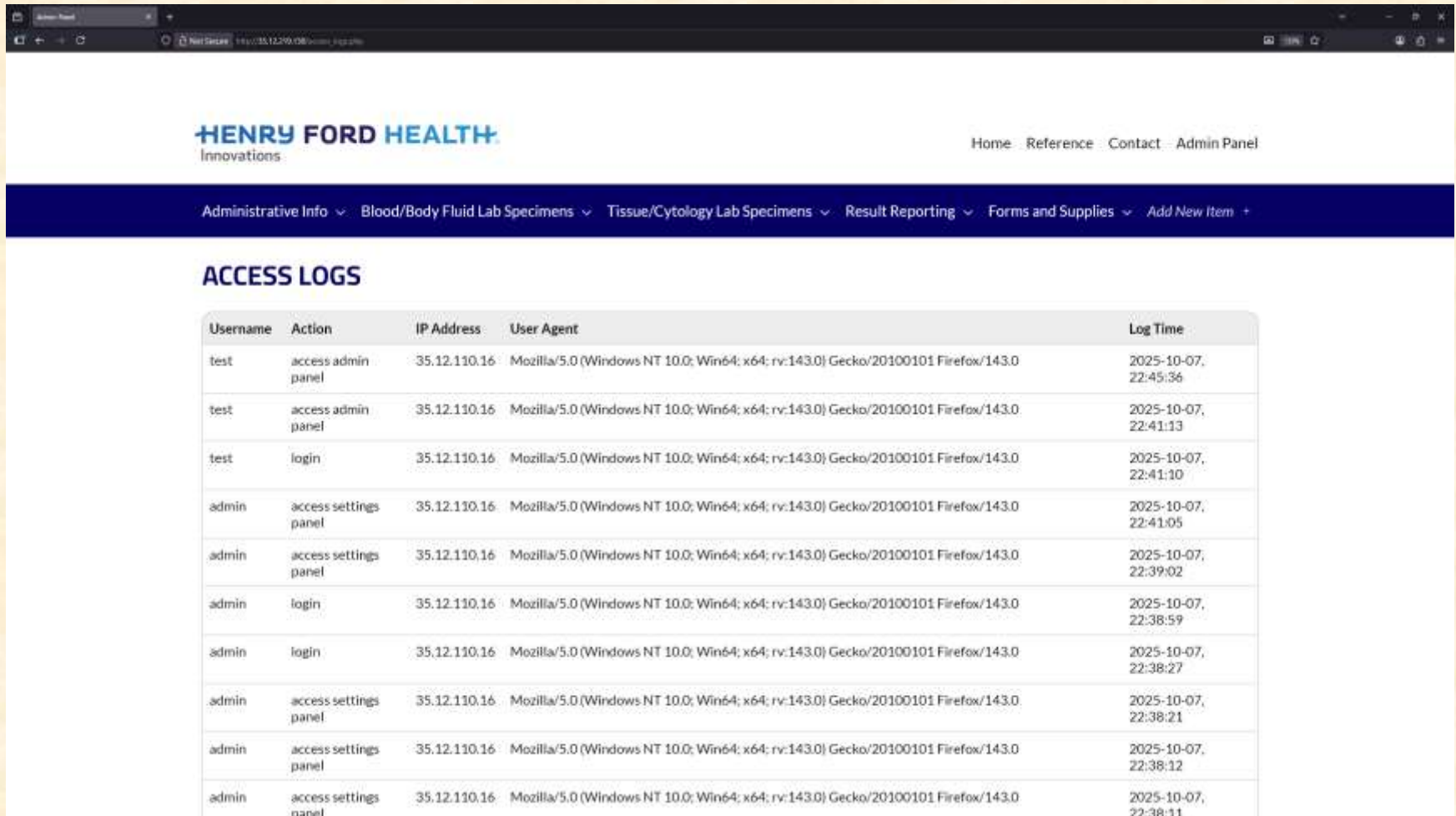
Consultation Request

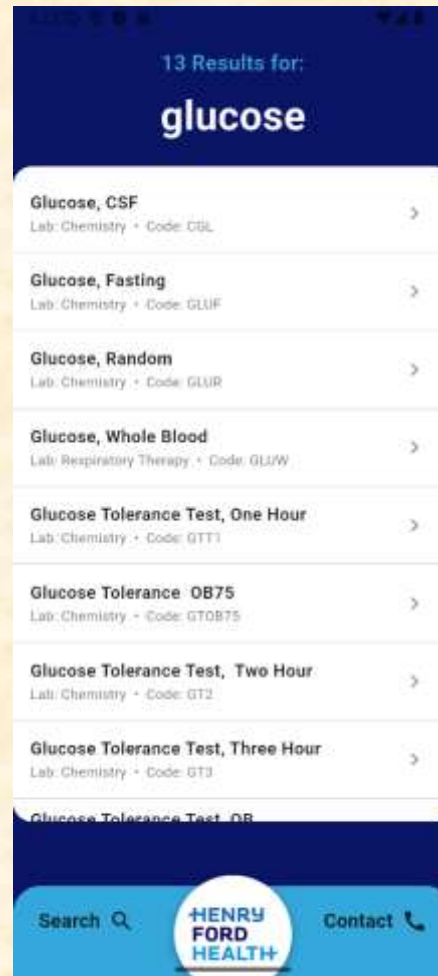

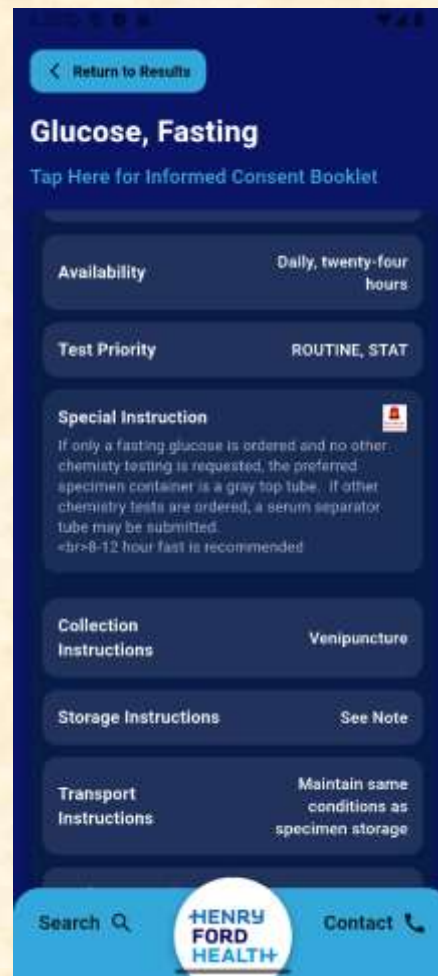
